# What are Consolidations and Editions?

#### Consolidation:


- A document that consists of amendments, corrigenda & errata rolled into the root standard. The document contains no new material and does not require a PAR.
- Two types of consolidations:
  - Revision Consolidation Draft:
    - Created for the purpose of having a draft available for a Revision PAR
  - Working Group Consolidation:
    - Created for the convenience of the working group

#### Edition:

- A product that is made available for sale
- Once the Working Group Consolidation is made available for sale, it is referred to as an Edition.
- The Edition does not supersede approved standards, amendments or corrigenda.

### **Requirements for Requesting a Consolidation**

#### Working Group Consolidation:

 Can be requested after a minimum of every 3<sup>rd</sup> amendment or corrigenda

#### Revision Consolidation Draft:

- Requires no minimum number of amendments or corrigenda, but must be in support of a revision project.
- Requests for both types of consolidations must be made at least four months prior to the date they are needed.



## **How to Request Consolidations**

- All requests shall be made by the Sponsor or Working Group Chair
- Email requests to:
  - Michelle Turner, Sr. Program Manager Document Development (<u>m.d.turner@ieee.org</u>)
- Summarize what will be included in the consolidated draft
  - i.e., approved amendments, corrigendum, errata, and drafts that may have been submitted to RevCom
