


Figure B.2—The RM for IEEE 802.3 point-to-point stations

## Nov 1, NEA Ad hoc "Passing Priority PLCA"

Reviewed status of "comment 573".

There was some resistance to passing the priority/importance bits to the MAC/PHY.

Next step is to gather support from 802.3 and generate a CFI if enough interest is shown. Soonest for CFI would be March 2019.

## Status

- Plumbing the priority/importance values down to the MAC/PHY is out of scope for 802.3cg.
- A CFI would need to be presented to 802.3 to start a new project for this work; soonest date is March 2019.
- 802.3cg <u>timeline</u> anticipates going to Sponsor ballot in March 2019, then to Revcom in July 2019.
