Experimental and Standard Branch Text

- | IEEE experimental drafts
- | (1) The "experimental/ieee" branch is intended for IEEE work that does not yet have a Project Authorization Request (PAR).
- | (2) The "standard/ieee" branch is intended for approved PARs, for drafts as well as published standards.
- | ****Update needed**** Change to:
 - | (3) Within the standard/ieee/draft branch or the standard/ieee/published branch, use a branch name with the number of the IEEE Working Group (e.g. "802.1", "1588").

Summary

- | Update Readme files to include a description of the structure

- | Ensure the Licensing information is clearly attributed
 - | The IEEE License text applies to all IEEE branches
