 - b. Tony Jeffree as editor will prepare an 802.1Q revision draft including maintenance items and proposals for the D+Q merge and .1AC alignment
 - c. Panos Saltsidis will prepare a review of clause 8 and make a proposal for the necessary changes to faciliate a D+Q merge. A follow-on proposal on Clause 5 and the PICS will then be needed.
 - d. Discussion on Q-REV will be held in Interworking TG at future meetings
- 3. Tony resolved the ballot comments on the WG ballot of AB-Cor-1 D0.0
 - a. It was clarified that AB-Cor1 discussions would be held in the Maintenance TG

 - d. Agree to propose 802.1 email motion to initiate ballot

 - b. 0036 & 0037 on MEPActive were rejected as one state is sufficient, but text will be added to clarify this. Norm Finn will propose text.
