- 1. The chair, Glenn Parsons, read the patent policy and made the call for patents. There were no responses.
- 2. Tony noted that AB-Cor-1 was published in July
 - a. This then concludes Maintenance items 14, 27, 32 & 34
- 3. Tony noted that AS-Cor-1 D3.1 has concluded sponsor ballot and is ready to submit to RevCom
- 4. Tony also noted a revised draft Q-REV D1.1 was reviewed during the Interworking Task Group.
 - Several editors issues were reviewed and resolved http://www.ieee802.org/1/files/private/q-2013-drafts/d1/
 - b. The editor will request that the WG initiate a Work Group ballot
 - c. Given that there are proposed title/scope/purpose changes, the editor requested that the WG authorize a PAR modification
- 5. We continued to process the existing status updates.
 - a. A document is expected after the next meeting for the outstanding 802.1AS item (0061)
 - b. Panos Saltsidis provided a full text for 0100, Norm Finn completed the technical review on 0108, Ben Mack-Crane completed technical review on 0109
 - c. Panos Saltsidis & Nigel Bragg are still working on a technical review on 0110.
 - d. Ben Mack-Crane original proposal (without modification) was accepted for 111

- 6. Review of new maintenance requests
 - a. 8 new items (0113 0120) were reviewed. 5 of these (0113, 0114, 115, 116, 120) were agreed
 - b. Norm Finn was assigned prime for a technical review on 0119, and Geoff Garner was assigned prime for a technical review on 117 & 118.

- 8. The proposed revision of the 5 Criteria was discussed (https://mentor.ieee.org/802-ec/dcn/13/ec-13-0009-10-00EC-proposed-5c) and given that comments were already submitted by some participants, additional comments were not necessary.
