  - c. 802.1AC-Rev/D3.0 is in Sponsor Ballot but has not been recently ballotted
  - d. 802.1AS-Cor2 was approved Dec 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015
  - e. 802.1AS-Rev/D2.0 was out for TG ballot before the November meeting
    - No ballot this time.
  - f. 802.1AX-2014-Cor1/D0.3 WG ballot closed Jan 11th
    - Comment resolution this week in Maintenance
  - g. 802.1Xck not yet issued for ballot
  - h. 802.1Qcc/D0.5 has been out for TG ballot.
    - Comment resolution at this meeting in TSN.
  - i. 802.1BA-Cor1 draft is available
    - PAR is on Jan 26<sup>th</sup> 2016 NesCom agenda
  - j. Std 802d amendment PAR for URN Namespace was approved Dec 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015
- 3. Janos Farkas performed comment resolution on 802.1AX-2014-Cor1/D0.3 following working group ballot.
- 4. We reviewed and updated the proposed comment responses to comments received from SC6 on the FDIS ballot of 802.1Q-2014.
