- 1. The chair, John Messenger, introduced the agenda, showed the patent policy slides and made the call for patents. There were no responses.
- John presented and updated the list of current vehicles (drafts) used for implementing maintenance items.
  - a. 802.1AB-2016 was approved Feb 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016, published March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
  - b. 802.1AC-Rev/D3.0 is in Sponsor Ballot but has not been recently balloted
  - c. 802.1AS-Rev/D2.0 was out for TG ballot before the November meeting
    - No ballot this time.
  - d. 802.1AX-2014-Cor1/D0.4 WG ballot closed Mar 6<sup>th</sup>.
    - Comment resolution this week in Maintenance
  - e. 802.1Xck not yet issued for ballot
  - f. 802.1Qcc/D0.6 is available but has not been balloted.
    - A new TG ballot is expected following this meeting.
  - g. 802.1BA-2011-Cor1 draft 0.0 has been out for WG ballot
    - PAR was approved Feb 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016
    - Comment resolution in this meeting
  - h. 802D/D0.1 is available
    - PAR for URN Namespace was approved Dec 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015
    - Ballot expected following this meeting.
- 3. Janos Farkas performed comment resolution on 802.1AX-2014-Cor1/D0.4 following working group ballot.
- 4. Tony Jeffree reported that there were no comments received on the ballot of P802.1BA-2011/Cor-1, so no comment resolution was necessary.
- 5. We reviewed the updated proposed comment responses to comments received from SC6 on
  - a. the FDIS ballot of 802.1Q-2014.
  - b. the FDIS ballot of 802.1Xbx-2014.
