- 3. New maintenance items were discussed:
 - a. 0188: Transmission selection
 - b. 0191: Introduction items for P802.1Qbv and P802.1Qbu
 - c. 0192: References in clause 5.13.1, item n) not clickable
 - d. 0193: Clarification of points in time for scheduled traffic
- 4. We received additional comments from a non-voter which were dealt with as follows:
 - a. 802.1CM: deal with in comment resolution on current project
 - b. 802.1CB: enter non-editorial comments as maintenance requests on 802.1CB because there is no CB project in progress
 - c. 802.1Qcr: consider comments during comment resolution on current 802.1Qcr project.
 - d. 802.1Qch, 802.1Qci, 802.1Q-Rev: enter these comments into the 802.1Q-Rev Sponsor Ballot comment resolution (which will start during the next few weeks)
