 6.7.1 Replace "Default User Priority" with "Default Priority".
 6.7.2 Replace "user_priority" with "priority" (two occurrences).
 6.7.2 Replace "Default_User_Priority" with "Default Priority".
 6.7.4.1.1 Replace "user_priority" with "priority".
 6.7.4.2.1 Replace "user_priority" with "priority".

There are additional instances of ?user priority? that could be replaced with ?priority? in clauses 12.13.3.3.3 b), 12.13.3.4.2 d), and C.3.3.1 and Figure G-1. There are also instances of ?user priority? in 17.2.2 c) and in descriptions in the IEEE8021-TC MIB, IEEE8021-BRIDGE MIB, IEEE8021-PB MIB, and IEEE8021-PBB MIB. The IEEE8021-BRIDGE MIB uses (the majority) appear to be from RFC 4363.
