## 9. Retail:

9.1 Introduction: A further 2 application areas:-

- 3. Plant/facility management (e.g. doors, fridges, chill cabinets, remote gass stations, security). Very difficult and expensive by cable. Low performance requirements but must operate reliably for 24 hours.
- 4. Increasing trend to locate PC products on the shop floor (e.g. for customer look up, stock enquiry). Multimedia support (sales aid). Requirements as for office.

**9.2 Applications:** Table: number of terminals for UK/European supermarkets up to 30 (or more). More useful to state range - popular range of 4-6 in cluster.

68 kbit/s per POS terminal considered to be an order of magnitude too high.

Robustness also required in supermarket (essential!).

Download software requires much more than 4 Mbit/s!

9.3 Configuration: Number of stations as above.

Include credit card verification in all cases.
