
Guidance for progression to revised Standard


Summary

- This presentation gives 3 alternative ways to get a revised 802.11 standard approved at the June 1998 meeting of the Standards Board. Alternative 2 needs some juggling to get the SEC e-mail ballot and submission to IEEE.
- It looks to me that the comment for the ISO version could be submitted from the March meeting. However, we need to make sure the ballot has not been closed before. If so we need to make a pro-frma NO vote at the November meeting.
