Services Provided



- Server space during meetings
 - Web-site mirror with update
 - Document sharing
- Internet Access
 - Pro & Con
 - Gives people access to company networks
 - Cost varies wildly
 - As high as \$15000 at Plenary meetings
 - Not available at this meeting due to cost



Equipment on Loan



- 802.11B Wireless Access Point
- 8 port 10/100 Hub
- Toshiba Laptop for Server



What else do we need?



- CableModem Router / DHCP Server
 - Cost of SW for Laptop equivalent cost
 - Allows us to get Internet Access at meetings
- 8-port 10/100 Switches
 - 8 more allow 65 users
 - Cables to interconnect
 - Individuals responsible for their hub connection
- Wireless microphone



Cost US\$ (tax included)



 Purchased in Canada to avoid customs issues and ease warranty problems

• Switches \$77 * 8	616
• Cables \$15 * 10	150

Cost Per Person
