## Chief Editor's Wet Finger



- Minimum 2 meetings to close current issues
  - Gates start of WG ballot
- Minimum 4 meetings to converge WG ballot
  - Gates start of Sponsor ballot
- Minimum 4 review cycles to converge Sponsor ballot
  - Possible to shorten cycle to 1 month between Sponsor
     Ballots therefore taking 2 meetings total

#### How to work to schedule



- Where are we at?

    - Fairness
    - Implementation guidelines

  - Open Issues requiring consensus to be built
    - Bridging
  - State Machines Missing
- Identify Open Issues
  - Text unclear
  - Text missing



### How to work to schedule



- Each Section/Technical Editor to hold an open discussion at the end of each section to create a list of open issues
  - As seen by editor
  - As seen by members
- Lists to be delivered to chief editor on Wednesday evening and to WG on Thursday (am)
- Review list Thursday (pm) by WG
  - A chance for people who were not in a particular CR session to comment and add to the list
  - Straw polls to give guidance on missing issues (in addition to the work needed to develop D1.0) to TechEds / Ad-hocs



### How to work to schedule



- Technical editors & new or existing ad-hocs to attempt to reach consensus and close issue list
  - Drive for September for 1st review & draft text
  - Review in September
    - Comment Resolution for D1.0
    - Vote on multiple alternatives for outstanding issues
      - Adopt into D1.1
      - Items not decided we keep working and working
      - Vote to Create D1.1
    - Final comment resolution cycle between September and November prior to starting WG Ballot
