# Distinct Identity

---

- a) **Substantially different from other IEEE 802 standards**
  - b) **One unique solution per problem (not two solutions to a problem)**
  - c) **Easy for the document reader to select the relevant specification**
- 

- ❑ There is no existing 802 standard or approved project appropriate for wire line access using point-to-multipoint topology at 10Gb/s.
- ❑ The proposed project is a 10Gb/s upgrade for users of Ethernet Passive Optical Networks specified in IEEE Std 802.3-2005. The solution may include more than one Physical Media Dependent sublayer specification to support different power classes. The solution may include a 10Gbps symmetric solution and/or an asymmetric 10Gbps downstream/1Gbps solution.
- ❑ The proposed project will be formatted as a set of clauses in IEEE Std 802.3, making it easy for the document reader to select the relevant specification.
