Registration Fees & Deadlines

Standard: After October 2, 2015 and before 6:00 PM Pacific Time, Friday October 30, 2015

(UTC Time: 1:00 AM Saturday, October 31, 2015)

- \$US 600 for attendees staying at the Hyatt Regency Dallas
- \$US 900 for all others (including local attendees not staying at the group hotel)

Language

English is the official language.

Electricity

In USA, the power sockets used are type A, B. 120 Volts and 60 Hz throughout the country.

Currency – US Dollar (\$)

A dollar is divided into 100 Cents.

- Coins currently in use are as follows: 1, 5, 10, 25 Cents
- Common Bank notes currently in use are as follows: 1, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 Dollars

Dallas Taxes: (Sales, Hotel Occupancy)

- Sales Tax - 8.25% Hotel Occupancy Tax - 13%

Location & Time Zone

Dallas is located in the Central Time Zone in North Central Texas USA.

Airports

Dallas is centrally located and within a four-hour flight from most North American destinations. Two airports serve it;

Climate

- Average minimum temperature in November is 45 degrees Fahrenheit (7 degrees Celsius)
- Average maximum temperature is 67 degrees Fahrenheit (19 degrees Celsius).
- Dallas has an average November rainfall of 2.3 inches (5.8 centimeters)

Airport (DFW and Lovefield) Transportation

Transportation to / from DFW International Airport (22 miles)

- **Taxi fare** is approximately \$US 45.00-\$US 50.00
- Taxi service is available on the upper level of Terminals A, B, C and E, and lower level of Terminal D.
- An Airport Guest Assistant will be available at the taxi stands between 8:00 AM and midnight.
- Between midnight and 8:00 AM, dial 972 574 5878 to request a taxi.
- **Super Shuttle** is approximately \$US 17.00 per person, one way, and operates 24 hours a day. Vans are blue with yellow lettering that states Super Shuttle.
- The **DART (Dallas Area Rapid Transit)** orange line leaves from the airport and goes to the West End station, and guests can take either the red or blue line to get to Union Station (attached to the hotel via underground concourse).
- For transportation to DFW Airport from the hotel, guests can take either the red or blue DART lines from Union Station to the West End station and switch to the orange line to take to the airport.

Transportation to / from Love Field Airport (8 miles)

- **Taxi fare** is approximately \$US 20.00 -\$US 25.00

Ground Transportation – Getting Around Dallas

- Taxi - There is a cab station at the hotel front drive.
- **Light Rail Service** (Operated by DART – Dallas Area Rapid Transit):
- Guests looking to explore the city can access the DART red and blue light rail lines, as well as the Trinity Rail Express to Fort Worth from Union Station. Routes available to immediate downtown area locations include Dallas Convention Center, Dallas Zoo, West End Historic District and NorthPark Center shopping mall. Cost is \$2.50 per person for two hours of unlimited rides or \$5.00 for day pass.

- Hours of operation are 5:30 AM to Midnight.
