Recommendation

- Change the wording of 1TPCE auto-negotiation objective to be more specific and concrete
- Current wording:
 - The resulting standard will not preclude single pair autonegotiation
- Proposed wording:
 - Supports single twisted pair auto-negotiation as defined in 802.3bp
