- Slide 7
 - Total loss budget can be ??? dB less than 100G equivalent because of no Mux/Demux loss. Suggest 2dB based on numbers used for 4:1 in 400GE project.
 - Check rxpavg(max) for 100GBASE-ER4.

- Review/fix dates.

- Since objectives has reverted to “PMD”, need to recheck amendment scope text, suggest looking at 802.3bg (40GESMF) as a model.
