Registration Fees & Deadlines

Early: Before 6pm Pacific Time, Friday, September 5, 2014 – No Longer Available

(UTC Time: 1am Saturday, September 6, 2014)

- \$US 500 for attendees staying at the Grand Hyatt San Antonio
- \$US 800 for all others (including local attendees not staying at the group hotel)

Standard: After Early Registration and before 6pm Pacific Time, October 24, 2014

(UTC Time: 1am Saturday, October 25, 2014)

Group Hotel Registration Discount Policy

Instructions for Obtaining an Invitation Letter for in USA Visa Applications

The IEEE Standards Association can provide you with a letter inviting you to attend the session.

- You must register for the upcoming plenary session in order to obtain an Invitation Letter.
- To register for the IEEE 802 plenary session you must pay the registration fee using a valid credit card that can accept charges in US dollars.
- If for any reason you should be unable to attend the plenary session you may request a refund of your registration fee according to the IEEE 802 Cancellation Policy (<http://802world.org/plenary/cancellation-policy/>)
 1. Once your registration has been approved you may at any time select the link to “Generate a Visa Letter” from the dropdown menu under the VISA tab on event website.
 2. Log in using the same UserID and Password that you used to register.
 3. Provide some additional information that is necessary for your Invitation Letter:
 - Your Date of Birth
 - Your Place of Birth
 - The Nationality of Your Passport (i.e. the issuing country)
 - The Passport Number
 - The Passport Expiration Date
 4. Once this information has been accepted your personalized letter will be generated in Acrobat PDF format and then displayed on the screen for printing and saving.
 5. In addition, a copy of the generated visa letter PDF format file will be sent as an attachment in an email to your email address. These letters have the IEEE Logo at the top, are properly signed by the IEEE-SA President, and should be printable on any common personal computer printer.

TAXIS

Taxicabs are available at the lower level curbside, outside of baggage claim, at Terminal A & B.

Fare to San Antonio downtown areas start at \$US 29.00 per taxicab. (Up to 6 may share a cab, if both luggage and passengers fit safely.)

SHUTTLE SERVICE

GO Airport Shuttle is San Antonio International Airport's authorized and single shared- ride shuttle service.

- Shuttles depart from 7 a.m. to 1:30 a.m. daily to downtown hotels every 15 minutes.
- Passengers may purchase tickets at the airport's baggage claim area.
- \$US 19.00 per person to downtown hotels or \$US 34.00 for a round trip ticket.

VIA METROPOLITAN TRANSIT

San Antonio's public transportation agency offers service throughout the city including streetcar service within the downtown area.

To get downtown from the airport:

Go to the Lower Roadway (Arrivals/Baggage Level in Terminal A and B), across the marked crosswalk to the **outer curb.VIA's stop will be halfway between Terminals A & B, clearly marked**. You will catch **VIA bus route 5**, which operates everyday, and can get to beautiful downtown San Antonio in about 30 minutes for only \$US 1.10. Once in the downtown area, VIA's streetcar service offers stops to or near most hotels, restaurants, the convention center and many visitors hot spots.

DAY PASS (VIA): \$US 4.00 Day Pass for purchase on online in advance of your trip. A Day Pass is good for unlimited rides on all regular bus and streetcar service for the one day indicated on the pass. The Day Pass will be activated the first time boarding the bus or streetcar.
