# Highlights

- Conducted LMSC Sponsor Ballot on draft 3.0 following the November plenary.
- Resolved all Sponsor Ballot comments at the interim meeting in Dallas in January.
- Conducted Sponsor Ballot Recirculation on draft 3.1.
- Pre-submitted draft 3.1 to NesCom.

# 802.3ad Sponsor Ballot Results

- Ballot results: Approved
  - Response Ratio (>50%):  $55/61 = 90\%$
  - Abstention Ratio (<30%):  $3/55 = 5\%$
  - Approval Ratio (>75%):  $49/52 = 94\%$
- Comments received: 135
  - 89 Editorial
  - 43 Technical
  - 3 Technical Required

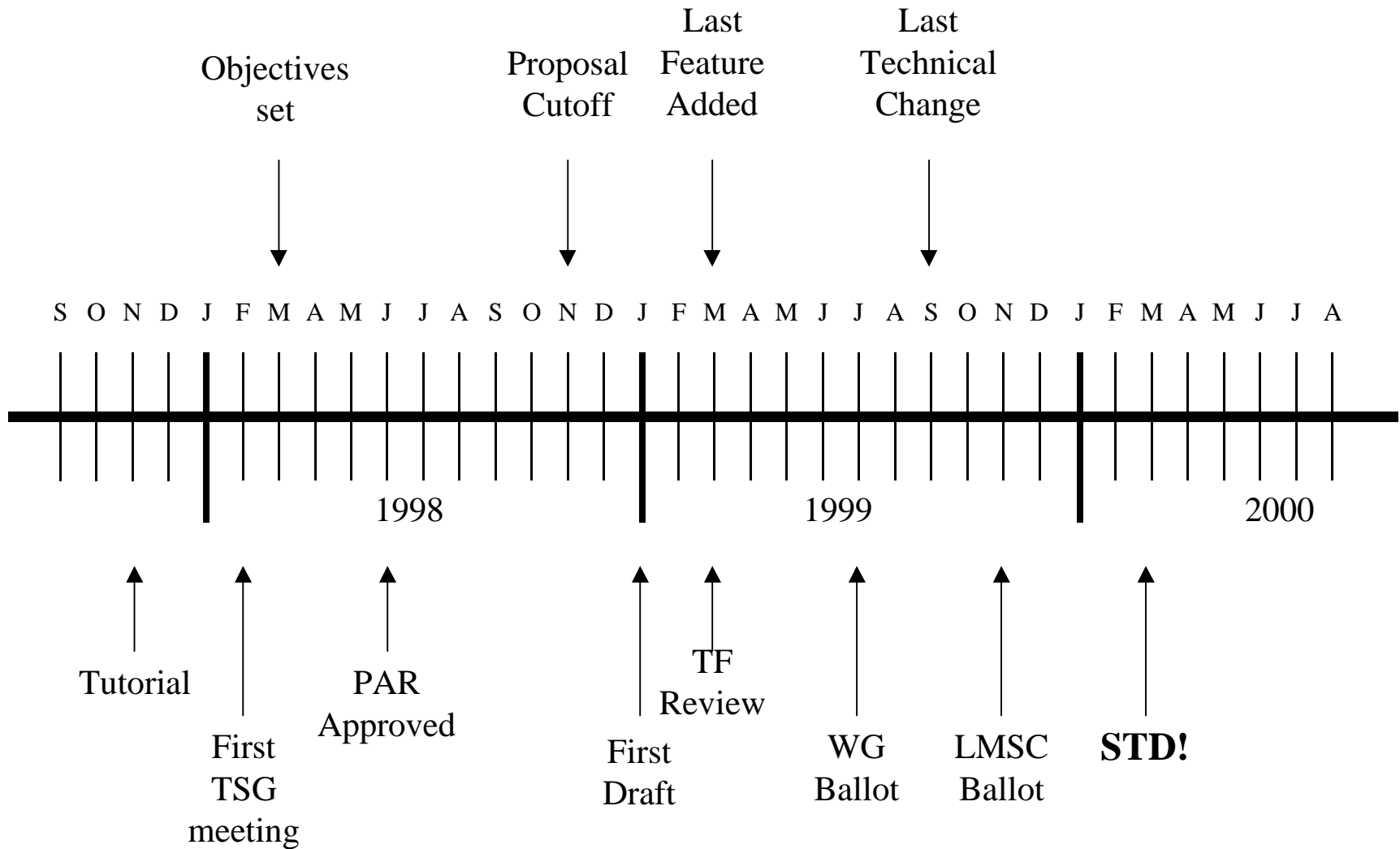
# Sponsor Ballot Recirculation Results

- **Ballot results: 100% Approval Ratio**
  - All previous “Disapproves” converted to “Approve”
  - No new ballots received
  - No new comments received
- **Document Package submitted to REVCOM**
  - On the March 28 meeting agenda for final approval of 802.3ad by the IEEE Standards Board.
