Meeting called to order at 10:05 am ET

Chair asked everyone to reply to email sent out with name and employer / affiliation. Chair noted that this information was being collected for the purpose of recording attendance in the ad hoc teleconference minutes.

Chair noted that while the call was open to all to attend, the agenda for the call was for the editors (i.e. those individuals who had agreed to help – Tom Issenhuth, David Ofelt) to discuss the development of the draft assessment. D'Ambrosia noted that the information gathering period of the BWA is reaching its end, and the development of the Assessment would begin in October.

D'Ambrosia reviewed the outline of the 2012 BWA document and key findings. D'Ambrosia also reviewed the presentations that had been submitted to the current Ethernet Bandwidth Assessment, Part II.

D'Ambrosia noted that the outline from the 2012 BWA could provide a basis for the BWA, Part II. There was further discussion regarding the outline.

The idea of developing or leveraging a network diagram to map the availability of submitted data was discussed.

Tom Issenhuth will reach out to Pete Anslow, who was the editor for the 2012 BWA, to see what Frame versions from the prior report might be available to leverage.

D'Ambrosia invited observations from the general call. One observation was shared that in the 2012 assessment, a consistent CAGR was assumed for the various sectors, which did not happen, as the CAGR began to decrease over time. Vlad Kozlov offered to help provide some help with the analysis.

D'Ambrosia and Ofelt will begin reviewing the submitted data.

D'Ambrosia is planning on presenting an overview of the development of the assessment at the BWA meeting in September.
