- Slide #17 Change “Pressure from within” to “East/west traffic”
- Slide #18 – add source to top500.org
- Slide #21 – add arrows to box at bottom
- Add presenter's name to title slides
- Slide #23 – arrows at bottom are graphically confusing. Change. Also, use Core OTN Transport in ITU-T application space
- Slide #25 – Change graphic reference to Mark Bugg from Tom Palkert.
- Slide #26 – resize GaAs Photonics picture
- Slide #28 – Use Gen #1 / #2 for interfaces. Correct names for OIF interfaces.

- Slides 35 and 36 - Look at using check mark instead of x.
- Slide 37 – Editorial rewording.
- Slide #48 – remove bullets related to HSE Consensus.
- Copy Slide #23 to put up front as part of introduction.
