

## Clause 45 summary

- 5 'TR', 7 'T', 11 'E'
- All but one 'T' resolved
- Loopback
  - Inconsistency between PHY XS loopback and all other MMD loopbacks.
    - Standard definition is that transmit is always from the MAC to the MDI and receive is always from the MDI to the MAC
    - But, PHY XS XAUI transmitter is in the receive direction
  - PHY XS loopback is now optional and is reversed compared to all other loopbacks.
    - i.e. it loops back from the receive path to the transmit path

## Clause 45 summary

- Jitter
  - Control bits added for 10GBASE-X pattern testing
  - WIS pattern seed and counter registers removed
  - 10GBASE-R pattern testing not applicable when operating in 10GBASE-W mode
- Unresolved comment: 're-instate power down'
  - Power down removed from PMA/PMD at the last meeting by a TF vote
  - And also removed from all other MMDs by TF vote
  - TF vote required to resolve this comment since it would overturn the previous vote
