# Items Requiring Further Attention

---

- Interference generator for receiver testing (14)
  - Broadband noise vs. swept sinusoid
  
- Interference level for receiver testing (17)
  - Correct interference level to correspond with Annex 69B channel recommendations
  
- 10GBASE-KR transmitter specifications need to be modified to guarantee interoperability (6)
  
- Channel recommendations need to be modified to guarantee interoperability (5)
  
- 35 people in the room

---
