We would like to inform you of the status of the P802.3bs 200 Gb/s and 400 Gb/s Ethernet Task Force and the P802.3cd 50 Gb/s, 100 Gb/s, and 200 Gb/s Ethernet Task Force.

The P802.3bs draft is in Working Group ballot phase, and we are happy to provide you with the current copy of P802.3bs Draft 2.2. We request that this be shared only with your membership. Please note that Annexes 120B and 120C use similar technology to the OIF CEI-28G implementation agreements, while Annexes 120D and 120E use similar technology to the CEI-56G-MR-PAM4 and CEI-56G-VSR-PAM4 implementation agreements, respectively.

The P802.3cd 50 Gb/s, 100 Gb/s, and 200 Gb/s Ethernet Task Force has adopted baselines and is in task force review and we are happy to provide you with the current copy of P802.3cd Draft 1.1. We request that this be shared only with your membership. Please note that Annexes 135B through 135E use similar technology to the OIF CEI-28G implementation agreements, while Annexes 135F and 135G use similar technology to the CEI-56G-MR-PAM4 and CEI-56G-VSR-PAM4 implementation agreements, respectively. In addition, Clauses 136 and 137 use similar technology to the CEI-56G-LR-PAM4 implementation agreement.
