- There are a number of clashes in proposed allocations in Clause 45 registers.
- Reviewed Register 1.7 assignment proposal. Need another bit for all of the proposed entries.
- Reviewed Register 1.17 proposal
- Reviewed Register 3.7 proposal. There will likely be a 25GBASE-T PCS type and need to assess the impact.
- Reviewed Register 3.8 proposal. Reviewed Register 3.20 proposal.

- Reviewed the current draft state of FEC and RS-FEC association by PHY type.
- Reviewed the various options in the proposal.
- Discussed Cl 74 implementation as mandatory or optional. Comment on tying CR-S and CR-L to an application space. Much discussion.
- Reviewed summary of options. Option B represents the proposal discussed last week.
- Matt Brown noted that Draft 0.1 has a placeholder for AN. No AN baseline proposal was adopted in January. {TF Chair clarification: we did adopt an AN baseline but we did not adopt a FEC resolution mechanism. See http://www.ieee802.org/3/by/public/Jan15/minutes_3by_0115a_unapproved.pdf see Straw Poll#3 and Motion #14}
- Discussed mapping the various options to the project objectives, the path to a no-FEC link, latency vs. BER margin, and engineered links vs. standards-based links.
- Mark Nowell noted that PHY designation is the big ticket item to address. The 2 AN proposals address ways to communicate and resolve the PHY designations.

Next ad hoc meeting is February 25, 2015.
