Ethernet Link OAM module **Rob Wilton** **Cisco**

- Discussion of overall approach taken with model.
- Discussion about how to indicate if a given Ethernet interface can support Link OAM.
 - Normal today would be to use “capabilities”.
 - If this starts to become unwieldy, communicate this to IETF folks and ask for guidance.
- Discussion on Configuration, Operational, RPCs and Notifications views of the model.
- Question about remote loopback – defined in 57.2.11 IEEE 802.3-2105
- Need to update references into clause 57 – a number of objects point to “57.1.2 Summary of objectives and major concepts” – can be more accurate.
- Further discussion of LinkOAM model?
 - Robert is not the subject matter expert, and will not be attending the July Plenary.
 - May be able to have someone attend a later AdHoc. Should co-ordinate with other companies to get SMEs on the same call.
