Attendance: Mr. Lingle advised the group of the IEEE meeting attendance tool and procedures, including both the attendance book and the web attendance tracking tool http://imat.ieee.org/.

Chair reviewed the IEEE structure for standards development and the bylaws by which the Task Force is governed.

IEEE Patent Policy: Mr. Lingle showed the four patent slides (slides 14 to 17 of http://www.ieee802.org/3/cm/public/November19/agenda_3cm_01a_1119.pdf).

Mr. Lingle made the call for potentially essential patents at 1:17 PM HST/UTC -10, and none responded.

IEEE SA Copyright Policy: Mr. Lingle reviewed slides 18-19 of http://www.ieee802.org/3/cm/public/November19/agenda_3cm_01a_1119.pdf entitled "IEEE SA Copyright Policy." Chair noted that there is no change in the policy, but an elaboration of existing policy, emphasizing that we should be vigilant in securing needed permissions and understanding the license we grant IEEE by using our own materials in contributions.

IEEE SA Participation Policy: Mr. Lingle showed the participation policy slides 20 to 21 of http://www.ieee802.org/3/cm/public/November19/agenda_3cm_01a_1119.pdf). Mr. Lingle indicated that the participation slides shown at each meeting have been expanded.

The Chair reviewed overall the IEEE 802.3 Standards process and where the P802.3cm TF was in that process: Standards Association ballot phase.

The Chair then showed the locations of the approved project documents – PAR, CSD and Objectives. He then reviewed the TF Timeline. Note: Timeline has project completing in December 2019. However, the Standards Association Standards Board (SASB) - that provides final approval (after RevCom review and recommendation) - will not meet in December 2019 (as it has always done in the past) but met in the first week of November. As this is the week prior to the November IEEE 802 plenary meeting the next opportunity we have for IEEE P802.3cm to be considered for approval is January 2020. So the earliest date for project/standard completion is now January 2020 - we are on track to meet that date.

Chair showed TF Standards Association D3.1 ballot results: slide 32 of http://www.ieee802.org/3/cm/public/September19/agenda_3cm_01_0919.pdf, but deferred to Chief Editor's report in covering ballot result details.

Titles and links for all presentations/contributions for this meeting were shown. There were no technical contributions for this meeting.

Schedule for TF meeting on Wednesday, November 13 was reviewed.
