#### Requirements to Proceed to WG Ballot

- Before a draft is submitted to WG letter ballot it shall in addition have met the following requirements:
  - a) It must be complete with no open technical issues.
  - b) It must be made available for pre-view by the membership <u>at least 10 days</u> prior to the Working Group meeting where the draft will be considered. If any changes are made to the draft after it was made available for pre-view, the changes shall be presented for review prior to the vote for approval to go to WG ballot.
  - c) It must be formatted according to the IEEE style selected by the WG Chair. This style will be selected to minimize the editorial work required for publication of the draft.
  - d) During a plenary week, it must be approved for submittal to WG ballot at the WG closing plenary.

#### Comment Resolution Process (.3ck,.3cu,.3ct)

#### • Baseline Terminology

- "Open" comments comments that Task Force have not agreed upon a remedy
- "Closed" comments comments that Task Force have agreed upon a remedy
- "Final" comments Task Force has approved motion to adopt the responses to the closed comments
- Post updated comment database after each meeting
  - Allow individuals (other than commenter) two business days (AoE) to request on the reflector a "Closed" comment from the prior meeting only be considered for reopening
  - Individual needs to be present at next meeting to address
  - Normal procedures within the group will apply to determine if comment will be reopened
- After all comments closed normal procedures to adopt responses and generate next draft will be followed
  - Comments can not be re-opened after meeting where responses are adopted by TF

#### Note about Comment Resolutions Going Forward

- Consensus building will be key
  - Rule #1 Use the Reflector
  - Rule #2 See Rule #1
- Reference: IEEE SA Balloting and Comment Resolution Process Guidelines (<u>https://standards.ieee.org/content/dam/ieee-</u> <u>standards/standards/web/governance/revcom/guidelines.pdf</u>)
  - Multiple reasons possible for rejecting comment given
    - a statement that the CRG could not reach consensus on the changes necessary to address the comment;

# Voting

There are two type of votes in the TF; votes on motions and votes in straw polls.

In face-to-face meetings where a TF is operating with membership rules for voting (see 3.3) only the TF members may make and vote on motions. In face-to-face meetings where membership rules are not in force all TF participants may make and vote on motions, subject only to the provision that they believe that they are qualified to vote on the matter before the TF. Electronic meetings shall only consider motions to progress a draft and only when balloting is substantially complete. Electronic meetings that will consider motions shall be approved by the WG Chair prior to the meeting announcement. In such meetings only IEEE 802.3 Working Group members may make and vote on motions. If a motion is not approved by unanimous consent it shall be taken as a roll call vote

In all cases, regardless of any membership rules that may or may not be in force, all participants who feel qualified may participate in a straw poll.

### **Presentation Requests**

- For IEEE P802.3ct (Presentations in support of comments submitted against IEEE P802.3ct D1.2), presentation requests must be made the Friday before the meeting, and presentations submitted the Monday before the meeting. Presentation time will be limited to 10 min.
- For IEEE P802.3cw, request deadline is two Mondays before the meeting, and presentation submitted the Thursday before the meeting. Presentation time will be limited to 15 min.
