Subject: VDSL Line Code Evaluation and Decision

Dear Mr. Frazier,

Thank you for your liaison received November 19 concerning the VDSL linecode selection schedule. The liaison was reviewed and discussed at our November 18-22, 2002, meeting in Atlanta. Part of the discussion centered around our need to produce a high-quality standard that has the support of our members and to do so in a timely manner.

Attached is a timeline from T1E1.4 contribution T1E1.4/2002-234 that outlines the goals of our work program for the VDSL line code selection and gives the schedule on which we have been basing our efforts. As you can see in that schedule, we are expecting to complete the test plan in mid February and expect test results from the test labs by May 23, 2003. In that timeline a line-code decision would be made at the next scheduled meeting in August.

To help accommodate your request for an earlier decision, we have tentatively scheduled an interim meeting for either June 18, 19 or July 16, 17 and will make every effort to make the line-code decision at that time if conclusive test lab data is available. The confirmation to hold the interim meeting and the choice between those two dates to will be reviewed at both of our February and May meetings based on our progress and the progress of the test labs at those times. We will keep IEEE 802.3ah informed of our view of the schedule as we move forward in this work.

Please note that this decision would represent a working group agreement that is expected to lead to a new VDSL draft Standard that would be submitted to the Committee T1 Letter Ballot process.
