Comments on comments

Quality of comments better than last draft

Quantity lower, especially given "hangover"

Please make sure that Clause, subclause, page and line are all correct

It makes the comments easier to sort

Note that subclause = 61.1.2.4, not 1.2.4 (include the Clause number)

The sick remedy problem

It's crucial that the remedy contains enough information to make the change

If in doubt, rewrite it as you want it

 Preparation is the better part of valor!
 Make notes in advance, use the spreadsheet We need to race through comments
