- Alessandro – polled top 25 cat6500 customers, by unit volume (early 2005) Data Center + Campus
 - 45% LX4 (commonality covers campus and DC)
 - 35% SR
 - 20% LR
- Peter P: robustness is important in HPCC, 100 to 150m (mostly 100), no need for reuse, “new build”
- Alessandro, data centers have high B/W needs outside as well as inside the “building”, 10km covers 95% of requirements
