IEEE P802.3/D2.1 ballot results

Mr. Healey noted that the first Working Group recirculation ballot of the IEEE P802.3 (IEEE 802.3bx) Revision opened on February 7, 2015 and closed February 21, 2015. Mr. Healey reported the ballot results as follows.

Revision Request #1273

This revision request was discussed. It was noted that this topic is relevant to activity currently taking place in the IEEE P802.3bt DTE Power via MDI over 4-Pair Task Force and the Chair proposed that this revision request be forwarded to the IEEE P802.3bt Task Force for consideration. There was no objection to this proposal or to changing the status of this revision request to “Ready for Ballot”.

Revision Request #1274

This revision request was discussed. It was observed that this revision request was related to IEEE P802.3/D2.0 initial Working Group ballot comment #83. It was also noted that this topic is relevant to activity currently taking place in the IEEE P802.3bt DTE Power via MDI over 4-Pair Task Force. The Chair proposed that this revision request be forwarded to the IEEE P802.3bt Task Force for consideration. There was no objection to this proposal or to changing the status of this revision request to “Ready for Ballot”.

Revision Request #1275

This revision request was introduced. The Chair agreed to discuss this comment with the Submitter to see if this proposal can possibly be re-submitted against IEEE Std 802.3bjTM-2014 or if the request can be withdrawn and submitted as a comment against the IEEE P802.3 (IEEE P802.3bx) revision. The status of this revision request will be set to “Received”.

Revision Request #1276

This revision request was introduced. The status of this revision request will be set to “Received”

Any other business

Bob Grow presented an overview of a group of issues related to 100BASE-T1, 1000BASE-T1, and 1000BASE-RH claiming compliance to the MII (Clause 22) and GMII (Clause 35) while using Clause 45 MDIO (refer to: http://www.ieee802.org/3/maint/public/grow_1_0315.pdf). Different options for resolving these issues was discussed. Mr. Grow will be socializing a proposed solution (refer to: http://www.ieee802.org/3/maint/public/grow_2_0315.pdf) with the IEEE P802.3bp 1000BASE-T1 PHY, IEEE P802.3bw 100BASE-T1, and IEEE P802.3bv Gigabit Ethernet Over Plastic Optical Fiber Task Forces and indicated that he will be submitting this proposal as a comment against the IEEE P802.3/D3.0 Sponsor Ballot.

Future meetings

The next meeting of the IEEE 802.3 Maintenance Task Force will occur during the May 2015 IEEE 802.3 interim session in Pittsburgh, PA. It was also announced that an additional interim meeting may be held on April, 8th 2015 in Durham, NH if an additional recirculation is necessary and comments are received during that recirculation.
