IEEE 802.3 Std. (IEEE 802.3bh) Revision Plan Review

Timeline and Overview

Mr. Diab reviewed the IEEE 802.3 Std. (IEEE 802.3bh) revision plan and the Task Force refined it further. The updated revision plan and flow chart will be included in the maintenance agenda and slides. The plan continues to support requesting approval for Working Group ballot at the July plenary session. Mr. Diab also identified and thanked the IEEE staff editors assisting with the consolidation project and reviewed the list of amendments to be included. A preview draft will to be available for Working Group review prior to the July plenary meeting in accordance with the rules.

It will not be necessary to submit a plan to RevCom as the PAR for the IEEE Std 802.3-2008 revision has already been approved by the IEEE-SA Standards Board and there are no outstanding amendments to be published prior to revision.

Detailed Plan Review

The group reviewed and affirmed the previous decision from the January meeting to place clauses 75 through 77, and associated annexes, in section five and clauses 78 onwards, with associated annexes, in a new section 6.

The scope of the WG preview document for technical completeness is:

- Consolidated edition with amendments / corrigenda
- Folding in the relevant maintenance requests
- Deleting GDMO (it was noted that the OAM alignment will be handled via ballot comment)
 - o Delete Annex 30A in its entirety
 - Delete Annex 30B in its entirety
 - Add a note in place of Annex 30A/Annex 30B that reads:
 - NOTE The GDMO specification was moved to IEEE Std 802.3.1-2011
- Add a note in place of Annex 30C, which was deleted during IEEE Std 802.3-2008, that reads:
 - NOTE The SNMP for Link Aggregation specification was moved to IEEE Std 802.1AX-2008

Mr. Diab reiterated that some members had expressed interest in volunteering to help on the project and requested that any other individuals interested in assisting with the revision to contact him directly.

IEEE 802 Architecture Comment Review

As there was some time left after completing the approved agenda, Mr. Diab suggested to review the comments from the 802 Architecture ballot assigned to the 802.3 Working Group. Mr. Diab asked if there was any objections to adding this item to the agenda and none were given.

Mr. Diab turned the floor to Mr. Law who reviewed the 802.3 assigned comments against the IEEE 802 Architecture ballot. Proposed resolutions were discussed and recorded.
