PROPOSED REVISION TEXT:

Change 'reassuring conformance to within' to 'ensuring conformance to within'.

RATIONALE FOR REVISION:

The current text uses the word 'reassuring' (synonym for encourage, inspire, hearten), which is likely incorrect in this context. 'assuring' or 'ensuring' is likely intended. This issue existed back in 802.3-2012 and has not been remedied to date. It has been presented in IEEE Std 802.3av and IEEE Std 802.3ah back in 2004. I do not have access to intermediate .3ah versions to verify when it was first introduced in the draft. The issue seems to be limited to the .3ah clauses and any clauses derived from them (.3av).
