## **Future Plenary Meetings**

- Discussion of future plenary meetings held 14 March with EC Executive Secretary and others
- Forcefully expressed our displeasure at the 802 meeting planners booking plenary venues years in advance (all the way to 2018) without consulting with WGs.
- Inquired as to why there were NO non-North American venues booked, in direct contradiction to the vote of the EC to hold one non-NA plenary per year.
- Explained that Hawaii is not an "international destination"
  - Stunned to find that the Hilton Waikoloa Hotel, which was supposedly booked only as a back-up to Melbourne for March 2012, has been booked for the July 2015 and 2017 plenaries.
  - Suggested these bookings be canceled

## **Future Plenary Meetings**

- Pointed out that many of our attendees are forbidden to attend meetings in Hawaii, Las Vegas, and Orlando as these are seen as "boondoggles"
  - For those who can attend, increased difficulty in getting travel approval; extra scrutiny of expense reports
- Explained that 802.3 prefers Asian locations of Japan, Korea, and China as customer visits may be scheduled before/after the plenary
  - Singapore was a nice venue, but not useful for customer visits
- Pointed out that there is a place called Europe, and that 802.3 goes there every other year, e.g. Munich and Geneva for interims since 2007
- This is an ongoing battle, and this will be discussed at the closing EC meeting Friday
