- Requested conditional approval for RevCom submittal

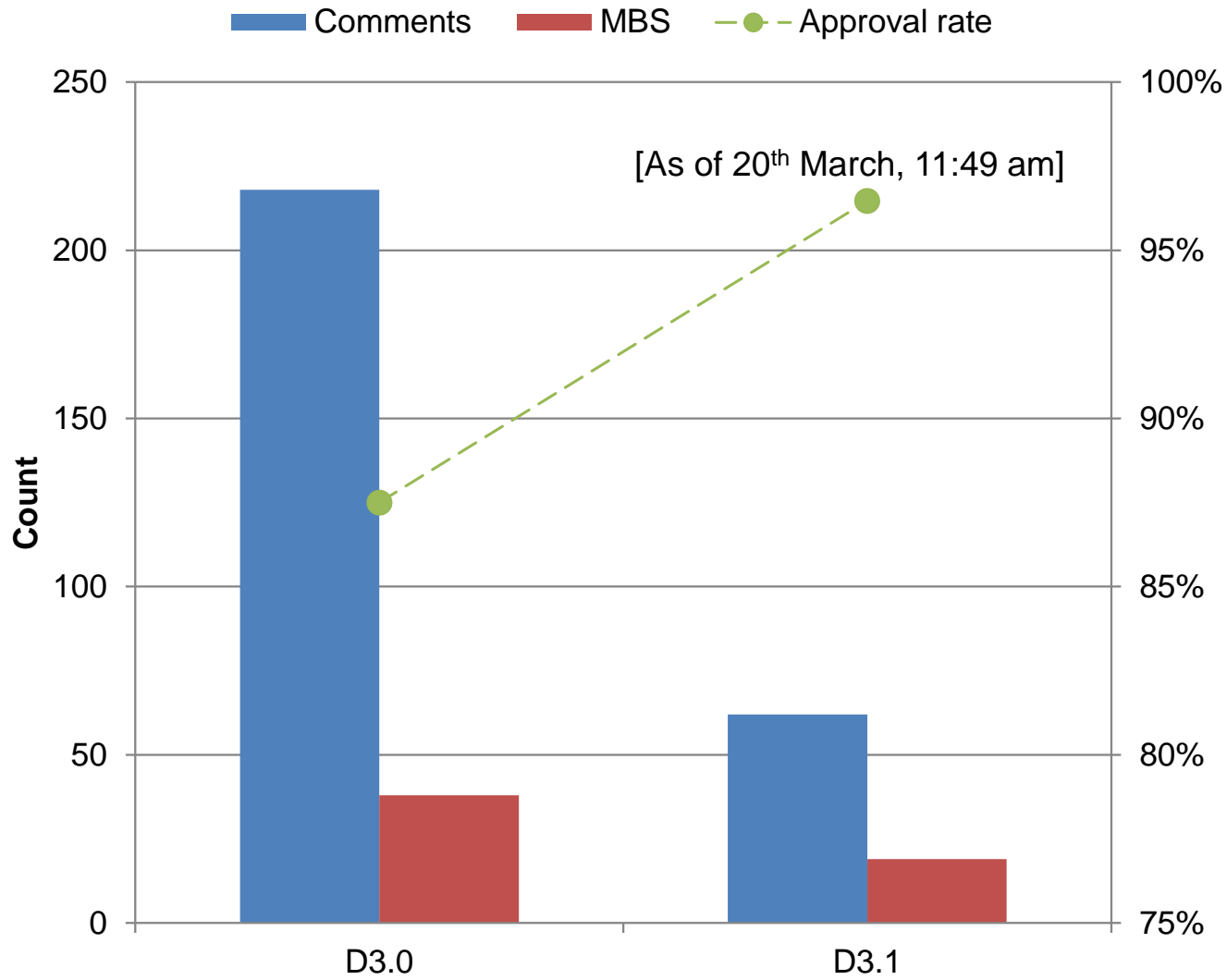
# Updated ballot response summary

Voters	109	Response rate	80.73%
Approve	82	Approval rate	96.47%
Disapprove with comment	3	Abstain rate	3.41%
Disapprove without comment	0		
Abstain	3		
Returns	88	Comments	62

- 9 ballots “flipped” following the close of 1<sup>st</sup> Sponsor recirculation ballot
- 3 remaining DISAPPROVE voters
  - 2 voters have not indicated which comments “must be satisfied”
  - 1 voter has indicated comments satisfied, but has not yet changed vote
- All DISAPPROVE comments have been resolved

- Request conditional approval from the WG to submit to RevCom
- Request conditional approval from the EC to submit to RevCom
- Conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> Sponsor recirculation ballot
- If the criteria to proceed to RevCom submittal are met...
  - May interim meeting will be cancelled
- If the criteria to proceed to RevCom submittal are not met...
  - Consider next steps at the May interim meeting
  - Schedule will slip by [at least] 2 months

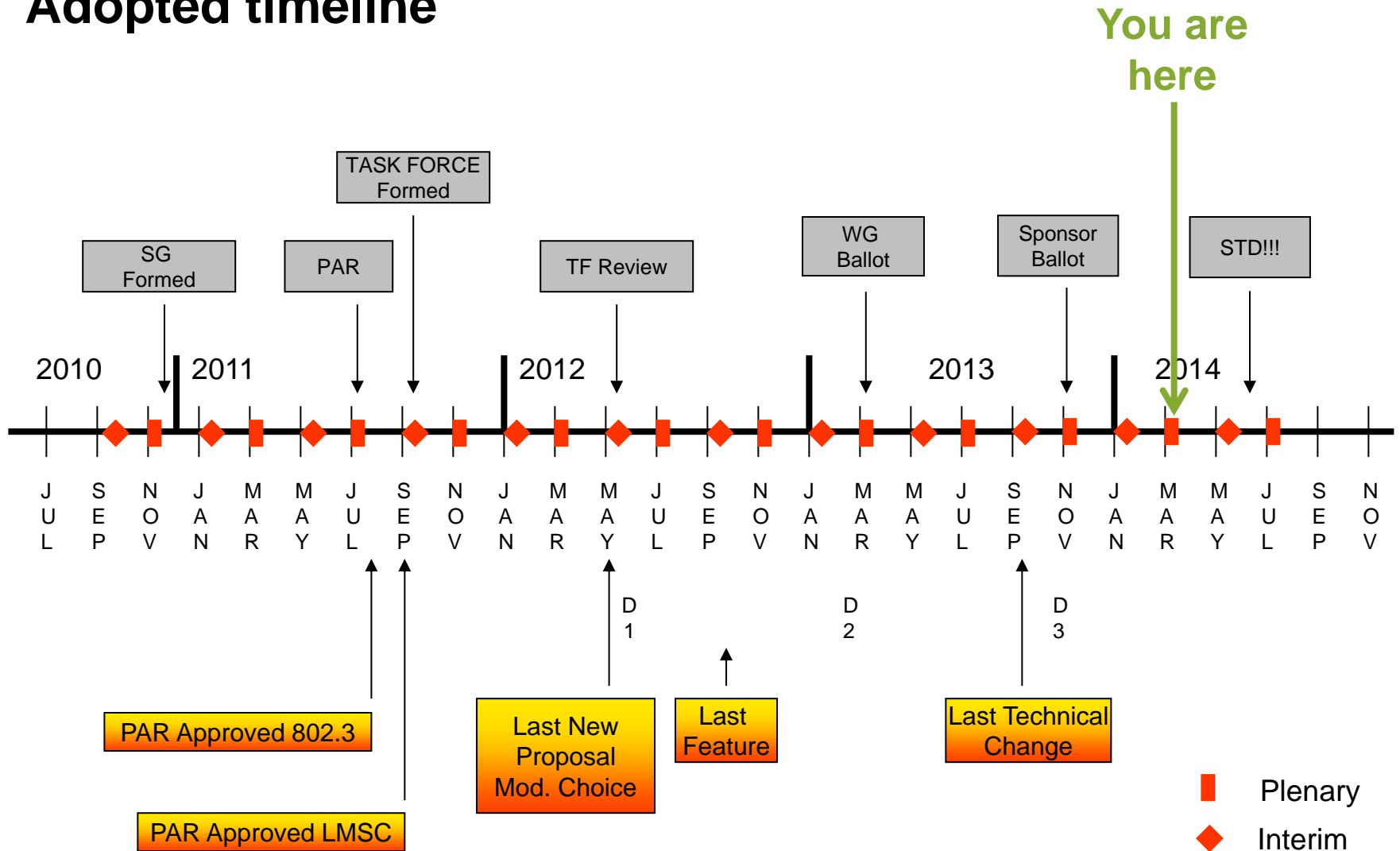
