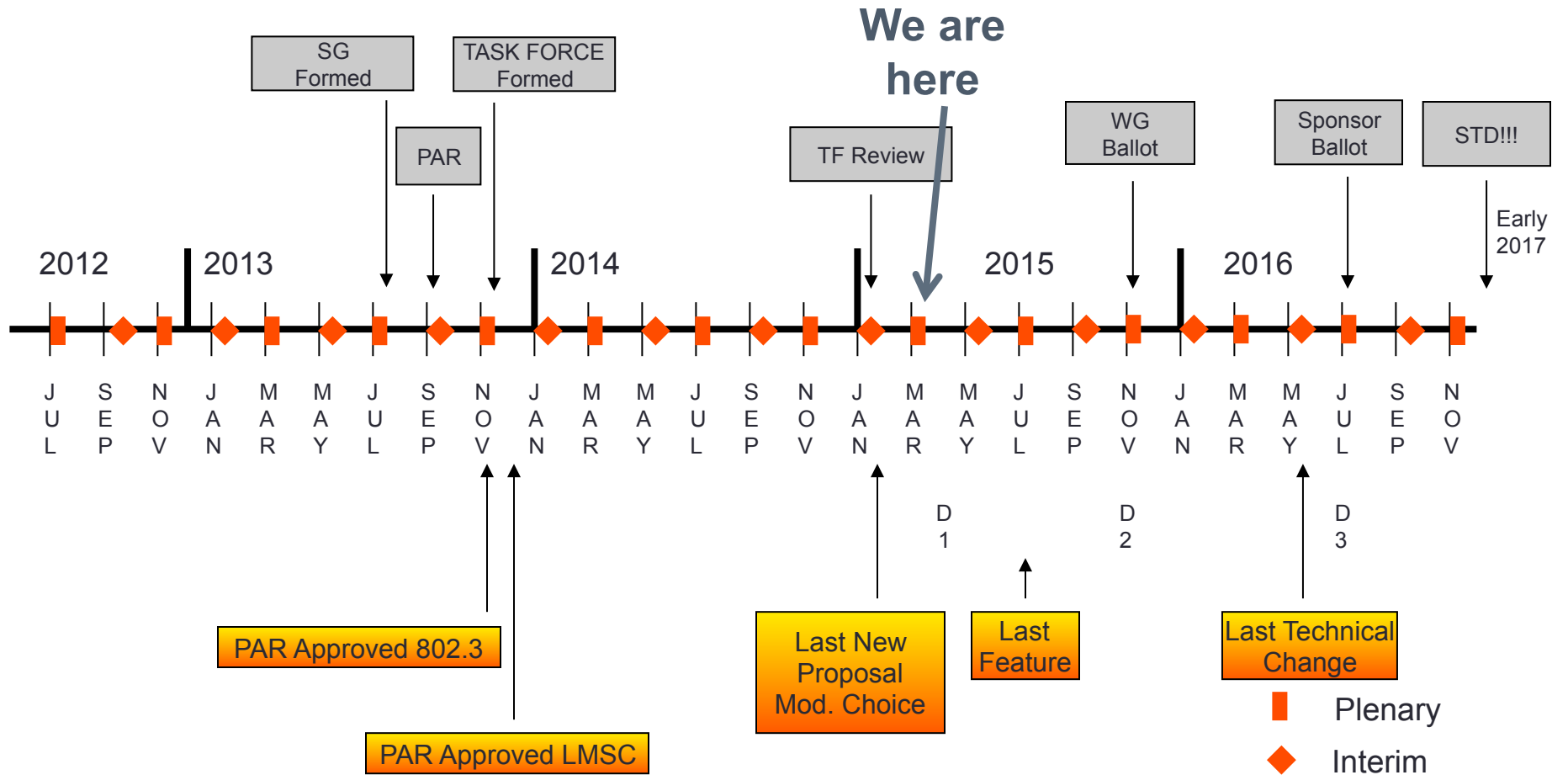
- 29 people in the room (with full 802.3bp overlap)
