Task Force organized

Major items

- Adopted core proposals for Physical Coding Sublayer

- Adopted project timeline

- Requested editor to include adopted proposals in a proposed draft

- Discussion of PMD status and plans

Current status

- Proposed draft (no official status) to be evaluated by TF

- Adoption of additional core proposals required to have technically complete draft

- Held a series of PMD conference calls to develop consensus

Goals for the meeting

- Continue adoption of core proposals
- Consider adoption of draft and initiation of TF review
- Develop plan for remaining big ticket items

Big ticket items

- Adoption of core PMD proposals

- Common (P802.3bp, P802.3bw, P802.3bx) changes to base standard (mostly Clauses 22, 34, 35)
- Environmental/safety specifications
- Complete management specifications
