- 5. Open a database of High Speed Token Ring issues requiring Working Group resolution
- 6. Decide on roadmap for technical work

Operating Procedures for Meeting:

- All participants must pay meeting fee (about \$80.00 per attendee) in cash, this morning.
- Motions decided by Straw Poll
- All participants are allowed to vote on all straw polls 75% Yes (of Yes+No votes) constitutes consensus > 50% constitutes majority, but not consensus
- Official Votes will be the basis for 802.5 Standards development to be done by electronic ballot or at official 802.5 meetings. Straw Polls are a useful gauge to help guide Working Group members, and often get confirmed by Official Votes as Working Group positions.
