# *LMSC Ballot Status<sub>(1)</sub>*

- *The following standards are out for LMSC and ISO ballot*
  - *802.5j Fiber standard*
  - *802.5r Dedicated Token Ring*
  - *802.5rev Maintenance*
- *Ballots close during April 1997*

# *LMSC Ballot Status<sub>(2)</sub>*

---

- *802.5 committee has a process in place for ballot comment resolution, prior to the next 802.5 plenary meeting*
- *Ballot comment dispositions will form part of the US ballot comment to ISO*

# *Token Ring and FDDI VLAN Tagging Format*

- *Joint meeting with FDDI to resolve VLAN tag encoding scheme*
- *Two presentations given from 802.5 to 802.1*
  - *Fix the frame format for VLAN tagging on ring media to be SNAP encoding*
  - *Identify the “hard cases” on legacy LAN*
  - *Change the ethernet encoding scheme to support end-to-end source routing*

# *Low Power operation*

---

- *New PC sleep modes are being standardised by Microsoft (“On Now”)*
- *Token Ring Implementer warning issued by committee*
  - *Implementations must remain compliant with 802.5 standards during low power operation*

# *MII Study Group formation*

---

- *Request to form a 802.5 Study Group*
- *To investigate the standardisation of a Media Independant Interface for Token Ring (MII-TR)*
- *Call for papers, to be presented at the next meeting of 802.5*

# *Other Business*

---

- *802.5 will not be holding an interim meeting before the next plenary meeting in July 1997*
