Meetings and Quorums

- Work Group (WG) meetings held during plenary are always quorate.
- Other qualifying WG meetings can make plenary decisions if quorate.
- A quorum is at least one-half of the Working Group members.
- A vote is carried by a 75% approval of those members voting "Approve" and "Do Not Approve".

QUALIFIED WG MEETING

- Reasonable notification (>4 weeks)
- Few last minute shifts in location (<< 1 per year)
- Notification to all Working Group members, observers and liaison people (in addition to any announcement given at a Plenary).

Becoming a Voting Member

- Attend 2 out of 4 *MEETINGS*
- Membership starts at *next* Plenary
- Continue to attend 2 out of 4 *Meetings* to retain Membership.
- Meaning of *Meetings* and *Next* is being worked.
