# Before we Share Our Views...

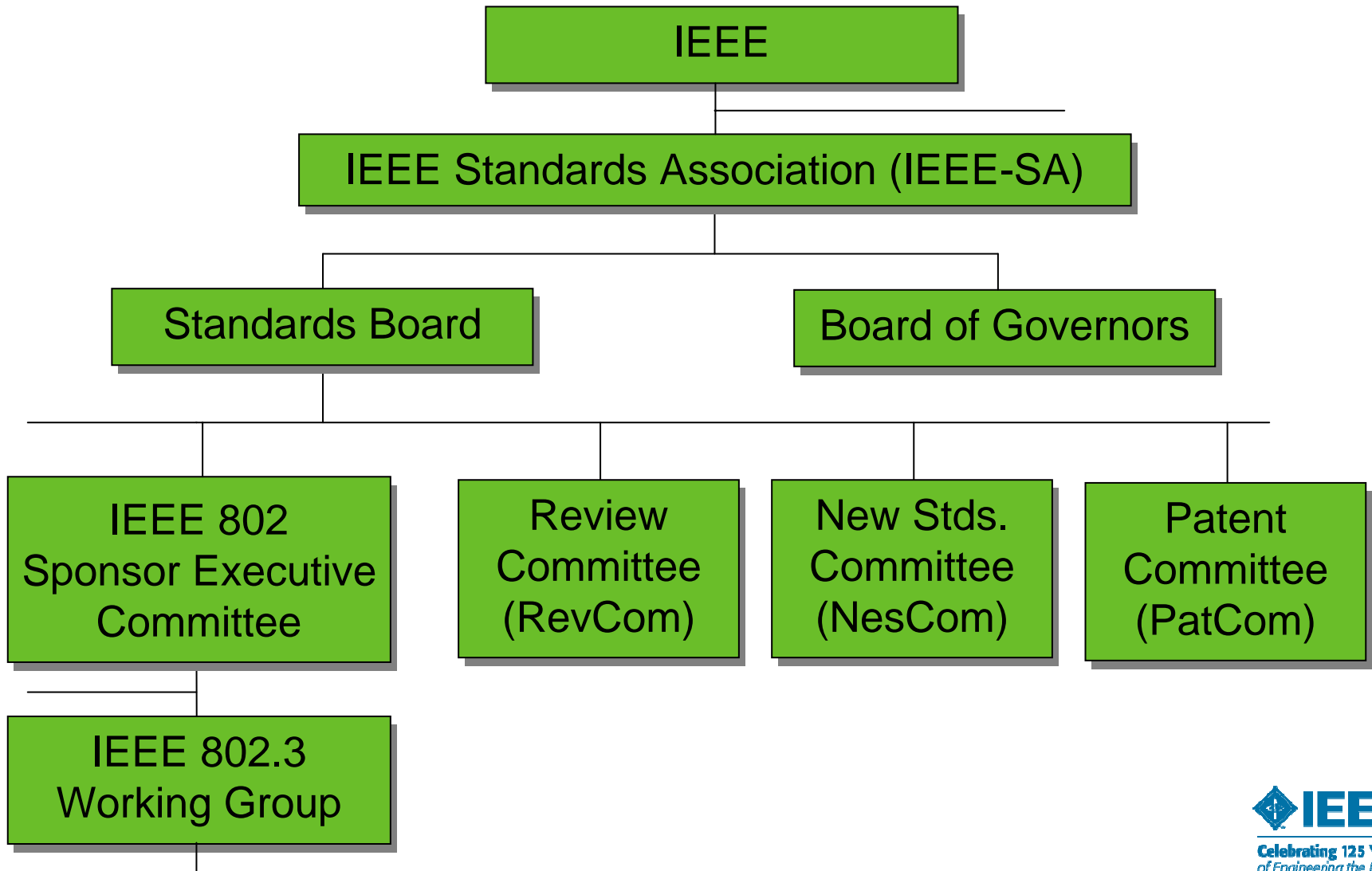

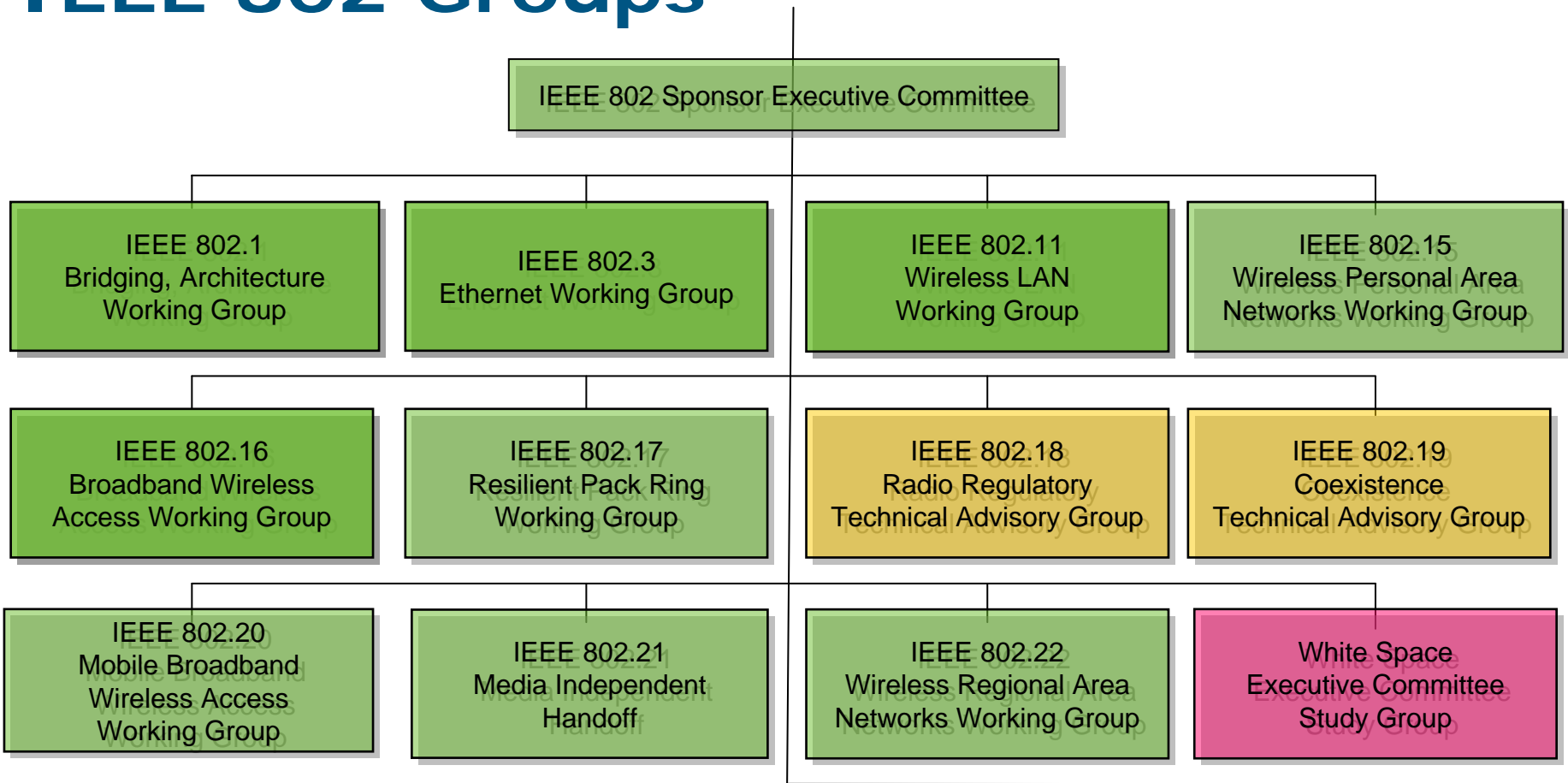

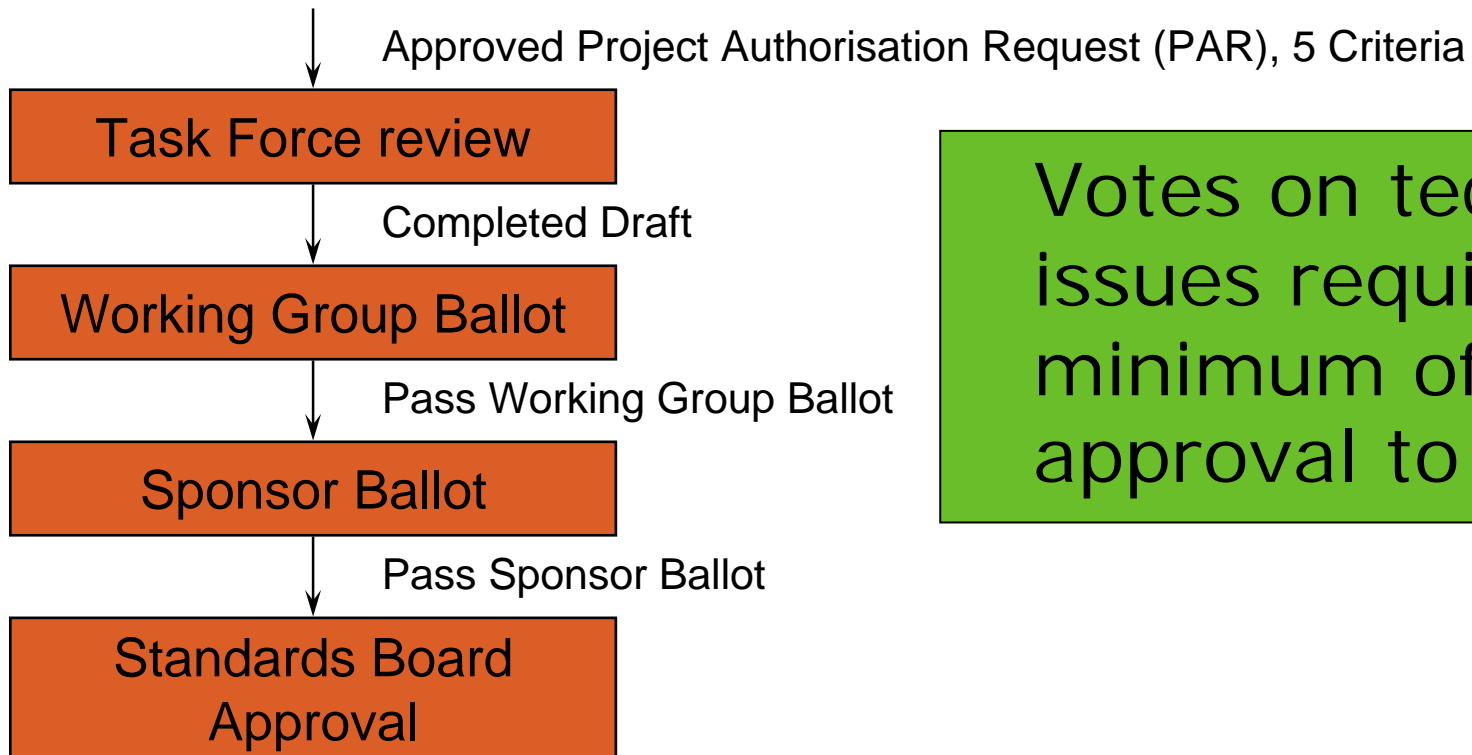
