The following is the Clause 14 'Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard' report for IEEE P802.3bf Time Synchronization which received conditional approval to proceed to RevCom submittal at the March 2011 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

The recirculation and resolution occurred essentially in accordance with the plan presented.

b) After resolution of the recirculation ballot is completed, the approval percentage is at least 75% and there are no new DISAPPROVE votes.
