The following is the Clause 12 'Procedure for conditional approval to forward a draft standard' report for I EEE P802.3 (IEEE 802.3bx) Maintenance #11 (revision) which received conditional approval to proceed to RevCom submittal at the July 2015 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

a) Recirculation ballot is completed. Generally, the recirculation ballot and resolution should occur in accordance with the schedule presented at the time of conditional approval

The recirculation balloting is complete. The second recirculation ballot occurred essentially in accordance of the plan presented.

The schedule presented to July 2015 closing IEEE 802 EC meeting when conditional approval was granted was:

b) After resolution of the recirculation ballot is completed, the approval percentage is at least 75% and there are no new valid DISAPPROVE votes.

The approval rate is 100%. A new disapprove vote was submitted, but it was without comment, hence the approval rate is 100%.

Please see item (a) for the date the ballot closed and item (b) for the vote tally. A new disapprove vote was submitted, but it was without comment, hence the approval rate is 100%. There are therefore no comments associated with remaining disapprove votes.
