Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Deadline: 72 Hours Before Arrival

Hotel room reservations can be canceled free of charge without penalty until 72 Hours (3 days) prior to reservation Check IN Date.

Afterwards a cancellation fee for one night's accommodations will be made to the credit card on file and the remainder of the reservation canceled.

This penalty applies to each of the reserved rooms canceled after the cancellation deadline.

No Show Policy

In case of no show, the penalty of 100% of the contracted room rate, per room, for one night, applies and will be charged.

Early Check Out Policy

In the event a Meeting attendee who has reserved a room within the Room Block checks out prior to the reserved checkout date, the Hotel shall charge an early departure fee of one night charge.

Subject to Availability
