

IEEE P802.3 (IEEE 802.3bh) Ethernet Maintenance #10 (Revision) Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard

The following is the Clause 14 'Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard' report for IEEE P802.3 (IEEE 802.3bh) Ethernet Maintenance #10 (Revision) which received conditional approval to proceed to Sponsor ballot at the November 2011 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

a) Recirculation ballot is completed. Generally, the recirculation ballot and resolution should occur in accordance with the schedule presented at the time of conditional approval.

The schedule presented to November 2011 closing IEEE 802 EC meeting when requesting conditional approval was:

18 th Nov 2011	2 nd Recirculation Ballot Opens
3 rd Dec 2011	2 nd Recirculation Ballot Closes
12 th Dec 2011	BRC meeting in San Jose, CA, USA

BALLOT OPEN: Friday, 18th November 2011

BALLOT CLOSE: Friday, 2nd December 2011 11:59 p.m. AOE

There were no comments received so the BRC meeting was cancelled.

The recirculation and resolution occurred essentially in accordance of the plan presented.

b) After resolution of the recirculation ballot is completed, the approval percentage is at least 75% and there are no new DISAPPROVE votes.
