Ballot results

- **1833 total ballot comments received**
 - 1268 initial D2.0 ballot comments received
 - 565 recirculation D2.1 ballot comments received
- **65 unresolved Technical Required (negative) comments**
 - 46 from initial D2.0 ballot
 - 19 from recirculation D2.1 ballot
 - two comments added after consulting with balloter

Ballot results

- All of the unresolved negative comments from the initial ballot were rebutted and recirculated with the text from the commenters reproduced verbatim
- Of the 19 unresolved negatives from the recirculation ballot, 7 restate a comment from the initial ballot
- All 65 unresolved negative comments will be included in the 2nd WG recirculation
