ACCEPT IN PRINCIPLE. The provisions of the note restate provisions of the preceding bullet list (without technical modification) introduced by a "shall" at line 30. In particular the note is a rephrasing of security objectives (c) and (d), and its purpose is to draw attention to these priorities. Since the note has no technical impact (does not add a requirement) it is suggested that the comment and choice of editorial action be referred to the IEEE publications editor. One option would be the replacement of "shall be" in the second sentence of the note with "is".	

Since this text was not changed for this recirculation (from the initial sponsor ballot), the ballot resolution group is keen that the need for editorial action, to avoid appearing to add normative requirements in a note, does not result in a delay in progressing the standard.
