# Proposal



- In a spirit of cooperation, the ITU-T and IEEE jointly sponsor several activities on a topic of mutual interest.
  - Agreed by ITU-T TSB & IEEE-SA
- First successful May/June 2007 joint workshop on ‘Carrier Ethernet’
- Second workshop proposed form May 2010
- Responsibility
  - ITU-T supplies facilities & registration
  - IEEE-SA organization & sponsorship
  - Joint promotion of event



- Joint Workshop on Ethernet in Carrier environment
  - May 28, 2010
- Preceded by proposed ITU-T hosted 802.1 & 802.3 interim meetings
  - May 24-27 2010
- Followed by ITU-T SG15 plenary
  - May 31 -June 11, 2010

  - Must book direct with hotels




# ITU meeting facilities

  - Cafeterias in other UN buildings




