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# EtherType adhoc – phase 1

- Request from 802.1 WG to have early coordination on P802f
  - YANG model for EtherTypes
- Created at Aug 7, 2020 RAC

# Accomplishments

1. Separated two instances of EtherType ranges on the public listing (Note: "=" should be "-") to ensure that searches will return results for assignments within the range.
2. EtherType 0x0800 added back on the EtherType public listing
3. IT confirmed that all EtherTypes are on the public listing
4. IT confirmed feasibility of enhancing the .csv file to prevent it from changing some assignments to scientific notation
5. IT confirmed that the changes to the public listing (e.g., making data-of-assignment public) is possible to be limited to only the EtherType public listing

# Action items (1)

## Solution agreed, awaiting implementation

1. Enhance the .csv file to prevent it from changing some assignments to scientific notation
  - A popular convention is that a field formatted as = "text" will be interpreted as text. Microsoft Excel, Apple Numbers, Google Sheets, and LibreOffice all convert such formats correctly upon "Open".
  - Gating for P802f
2. Elastic Search improvements (i.e., search all fields instead of just assignment & company name)
3. EtherType public listing contains uppercase and lowercase letters - need consistency (preference from group is ALL CAPS)
  - Gating for P802f
4. EtherType public listing text file improvement needed - address merges with protocol description
  - Gating for P802f
5. There are EtherType records in the Public listing that have duplicate entries. Reconcile and remove duplicates.
  - (e.g., 0A00, 0A01, 0B01, 0B02, 0B03, 0B04, 0B05, 0B06, 0B07, 8100, 8101, 8102, 8103, 810A, 810B, 810C, 810D, 810E, 882B)
  - Gating for P802f
6. Consistency of EtherType vs Ethertype (EtherType preferred) on web and public listing

# Action items (2)

Solution agreed, implementation in progress

7. Align 802.1/802.3/802.11/802.21 assigned EtherTypes to have the same address, a description that is the protocol name and the standard reference.
  - 802.3 completed, 802.1 in process (88E7 needs verification), 802.11 and 802.21 in approval.
  - Gating for P802f
8. Editorial clean up of the “Use of the IEEE Assigned EtherType with IEEE Std 802.3 Local and Metropolitan Area Networks” tutorial
  - Currently an Appendix in P802f draft under ballot to collect comments
  - Separate out before SA ballot and update

# Action items (3)

## Under study

9. Consistency of hex representation of EtherTypes
  - No consistent style for identifying an EtherType value as a hexadecimal number [ 0800 vs 08-00 vs 0x0800 vs 0800 (hex) vs 0800<sub>16</sub> ] is defined.
  - RAC should define for its usage – ??? “0800 (hex)” preferred and “0800” for TXT/CSV/YANG ???
  - Standards define for their usage -- IEEE Editorial reviewing conventions for 2023 style manual
10. For EtherTypes used in standards, is it of interest to the RAC to introduce a “Short Description” field in order to clearly identify the usage of the EtherType (e.g., for registry entries that have “Protocol Unavailable”)?
  - **P802f** will define a short description for its set of EtherTypes
  - Incorporate a “Notes” field that the RAC will maintain?
11. EtherTypes below 0600 (hex)
  - Protocol should be marked as "Not valid as a Type value" rather than "Protocol unavailable."
12. Should the company/organization labelling in public listing (searchable database, CSV, TXT) be consistent?
  - If so, should they all be “Company”, or “Organization” or “Entity” or “Assignee”, or ...
